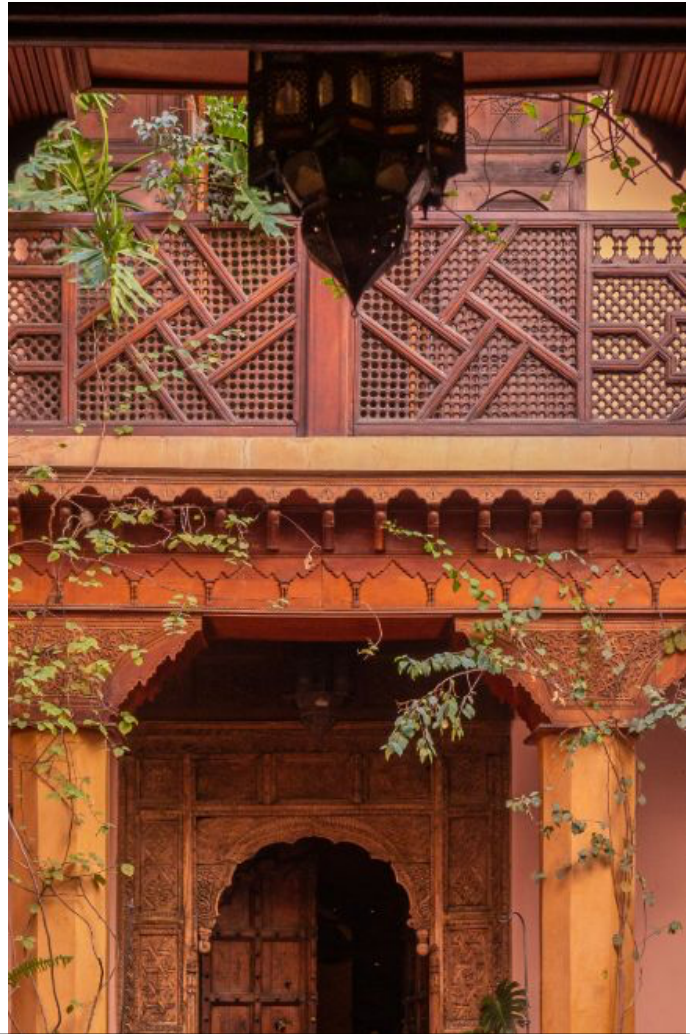

Day 1: Nov. 7: CASABLANCA / FES

Upon arrival in Casablanca, the economic capital of Morocco, you will be met by your driver in a private vehicle and head 5 hours to Fes. This destination is the spiritual capital of Morocco where the old and new coexist in intricate beauty. Dinner served at your riad but not included (paid for at time of service).

Day 2: Nov. 8: FES (B)

This whole day is devoted to exploring the walled-in city, or medina, of Fes. After breakfast, your tour will begin. While no cars are allowed, you'll see donkeys in the old city, shops with piles of vibrant spices, and storehouses heaped high with hand-woven carpets in every color and design possible. You'll hear the call to prayer, reminding the people to carry out their religious duties. This is a chance to see the real Fes. Your guide will be happy to offer information and explanation for the stops you'll make. Some of the other places you'll visit will be the tanneries, the King's Palace, Mellah (Jewish Quarter), Jewish Snanguague, and the potters. After winding your way deep into the medina, you'll get to have lunch in the heart of the medina (not included). After lunch, you will complete the tour and return to your accommodations for the evening. DINNER ON YOUR OWN.

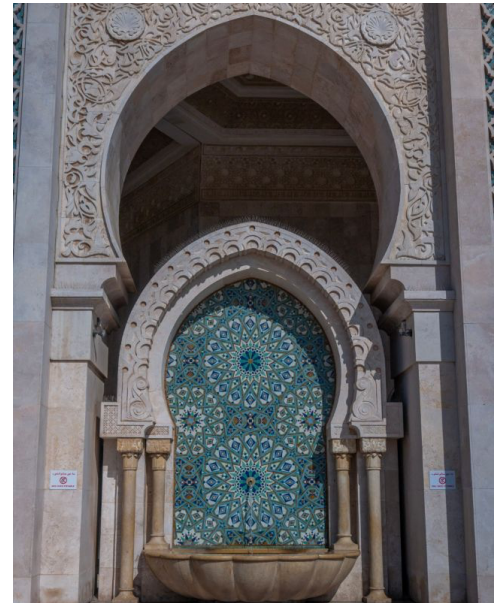
Day 3: Nov. 9: FES / MERZOUGA (B, D)

After an early breakfast, you will begin your ascent across the Middle Atlas Mountains. You will enjoy winding through the Cedar Forest and stop for a visit to see the Barbary Apes. Most of the day will be spent winding your way through the beautiful forests, jagged rock faces, and Berber villages as you cross the Atlas Mountains and begin to descend towards the Sahara Desert. You will head over the Middle Atlas mountains through the Palmeries. The buildings will fade into a dusty pink as you make your way toward the Sahara Desert. Listen as your driver shares his vast knowledge about the landscape and sceneries before you. On arrival at the Kasbah in Merzouga, a hot shower or dip in the swimming pool will be a treat after the long drive. Dinner will be served in the Kasbah.

Day 4: Nov. 10: SAHARA DESERT(Gnawa Music) (B, D)

After breakfast, take some time to explore the small, interesting desert towns surrounding the Sahara. You will enjoy a visit of Khamilia to experience the



heart of Gnawa music in the desert. You will learn how the nomadic peoples live in the desert and explore a bit more of the nearby dunes. In the afternoon, you will be driven in a Sports Utility Vehicle (SUV) across the barren land to the majestic Sahara sand dunes. Enjoy a camel ride as you head further in to find a dune to scramble up and take in the sunset. You will spend the night in an upscale Berber Tent including electricity, its own private flush toilets, running water, and a basic shower. (Dinner is included).

Day 5: Nov. 11: SAHARA / TODRA GORGES / SKOURA (B, D)

From the desert, you will take the SUV back to meet up with your driver. Together, you will head towards Ouarzazate. Along the route, you will enjoy a **short hike through the Todra Gorges** (600 ft high). The towering cliffs and beautiful palm tree valley make this a picturesque drive. Along the way, you could stop to see one of the famous Kasbahs as this is known as the 'route of 1000 Kasbahs' before arriving at the southern city of Skoura. Dinner will be served at your hotel.

Day 6: Nov. 12: SKOURA / OUARZAZATE / HIGH ATLAS MOUNTAINS (B)

Today, you will set off to Marrakech via Ouarzazate and Ait Benhaddou. Tucked away in the High Atlas Mountains, this massive red clay fortification is one of the jewels of Morocco. In typical Moroccan fashion, the true treasures must be searched out and discovered...usually off the beaten path. This setting has been used for more films than any other location in Morocco. Some films and TV shows include Lawrence of Arabia, Jesus of Nazareth, The Gladiator, and more recently Game of Thrones. Lunch can be taken at Ait Benhaddou (not included). After you visit this famous Kasbah. You will continue through the High Atlas Mountains until you reach Imilil, at the base of Mt. Toubkal. Dinner served at your riad but not included (paid for at time of service).

Day 7: Nov. 13: HIGH ATLAS MOUNTAINS (B, L)

After breakfast you will experience a half day hike into the Berber villages where you will have the privilege of understanding rural life and culture. You will enjoy lunch along the way. (LUNCH INCLUDED) In the evening you will return to your mountain lodge. Dinner served at your riad but not included (paid for at time of service).

Day 8: Nov. 14: HIGH ATLAS MOUNTAINS/ MARRAKECH (1/2 Day Guided Tour) (B)

After breakfast, you will head to Marrakech where you will enjoy a short guided tour of Marrakech, the southern pearl of Morocco. This city should be on every traveler's bucket list. You will discover the Palace of the Bahia, the different cloths and fabrics and many other hidden treasures. You may want to add the Jardin Majorelle – a 2 ½ acre artist's botanical garden.

In the evening, you will visit the center square of the medina, the famous Jemaa el-Fna. This is one of the highlights of Marrakech. Coming alive at night with the local storytellers, entertainers, and mouth-watering barbeque pits,

the square is well worth a visit. If you would rather observe, you might enjoy a quiet cup of tea on a terrace overlooking the square. DINNER ON YOUR OWN.

Day 9: Nov. 15: MARRAKECH (*Guided Tour & Cooking Class) (B, L)

After breakfast you will enjoy a cooking class where you will shop for your ingredients in the local market and prepare the 3-course meal. In the afternoon you could enjoy a visit of Textile Museum, Mellah & Jewish Synagogue, (Only if enough time Sadiaan Tombs) and ***Hammam de La Rose (Reservation for 8 pax at 5 pm).*** Dinner served at your riad but not included (paid for at time of service).

With an exquisite beach to the south, Essaouira has become one of Morocco's most popular coastal towns. Many of the country's woodcarvers and artists make Essaouira their home, filling Essaouira with incredible art and culture. The French designed city offers a bit of a European feel to Essaouira. Imagine seeing cheerful blue fishing boats packed together by the port as you explore before you head back to your hotel DINNER ON YOUR OWN.

Day 11: Nov. 17: ESSAOUIRA (B)

Whitewashed walls add to the fresh feeling as you find wood and unique artworks in this slower-paced Moroccan medina. The fortified seawall and the old cannons provide the perfect location to feel the strong wind on your face—Essaouira is well known for its coastal wind—perhaps inspiring you to give windsurfing a chance?
